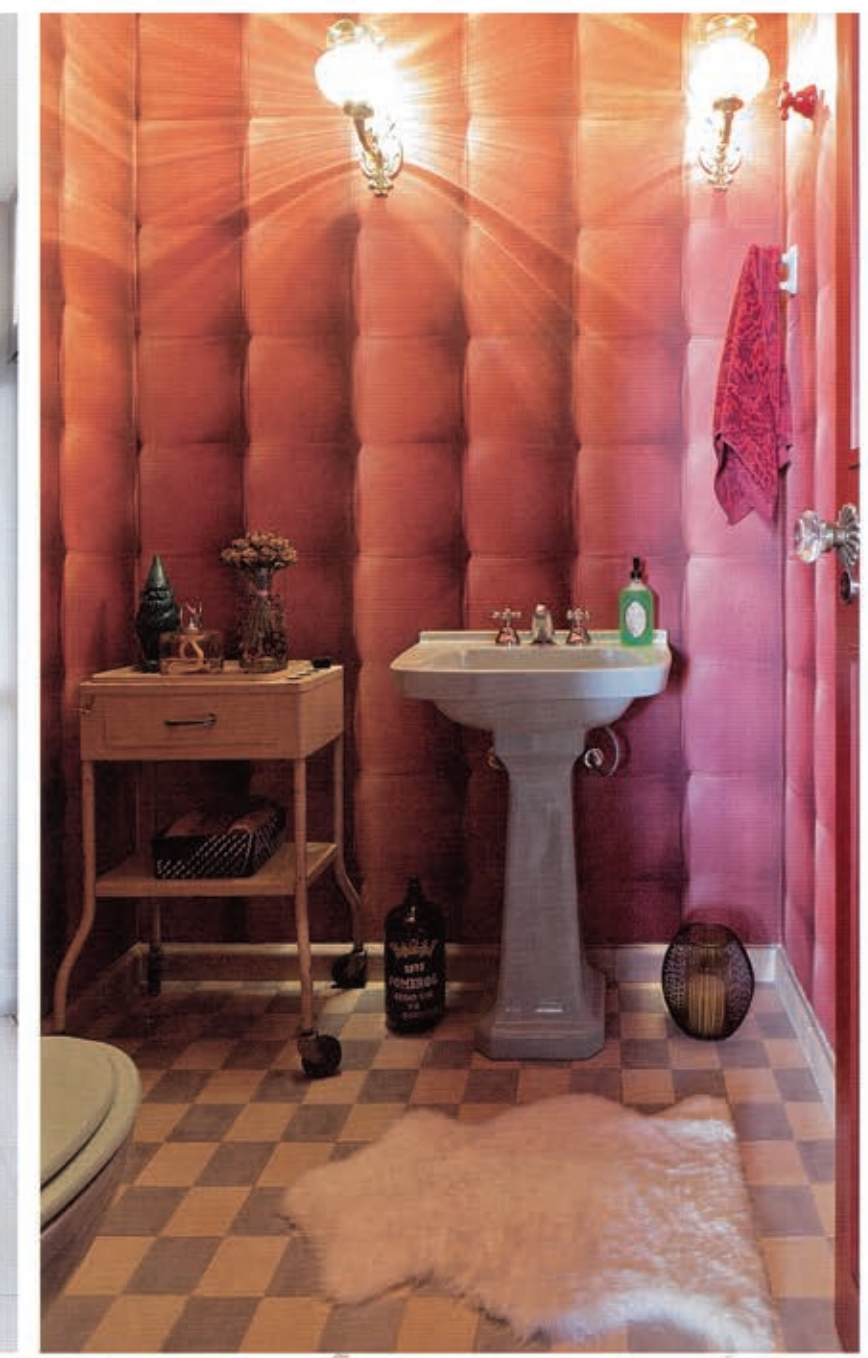
Exploding colors, this house just screams of Brazil.

This apartment was built 50 years ago and is located near Paulista Avenue, one of Brazil's more affluent business centers. The original floor plan was modified to better suit the needs of the new user. The apartment has good natural insulation and a lighting system that makes use of fluorescent lamps and directional spots to emphasize different aspects of the design. Brazilian designers, such as Marcus Ferreira, made some of the furniture and textiles used for the old chairs in the dining room were designed by Adriana Barra. The artwork was made by 'Nove' digital organico.



The clients colorful clothes and Brazilian lifestyle inspired the architects to create a colorful and open space. The entire design uses more than 40 colors in total.
